To take part in the formal Graduation Cap & Gown, students must meet the requirements or be in a position to complete a Saskatchewan Grade 12 standing by June 26, 2018. Students must also be passing all required classes by Semester 2 Mid-term report (May 7, 2018).

It is strongly recommended that Grade 12 students attend their JAG for information being shared during advisory time. This is also a time that the JAG teacher can review any academic concerns with individual students.

# Post Graduation Planning

Regardless of what direction a student wants to go after graduation, if there are questions about applying for post-secondary, what options are available, areas of employment, a guidance councillor is there to help.

Another tool available to students is [myBlueprint](#), an online resource that all students in Regina Public Schools have access to. It syncs with PowerSchool to provide an accurate look at what post-secondary courses and programs students can get into across Canada.

Other features of myBlueprint include:

- ↳ Interest inventory - a tool that helps narrow down what a student's interests are
- ↳ Resume builder
- ↳ Pre-employment planning
- ↳ Employment searching

For any help with myBlueprint, students should speak with their JAG teacher or a guidance councillor.
